


Hydro vault replacement on Queen St.

Starting as early as Oct. 3, 2022



What is happening?
 Work is underway to deliver the new Ontario Line from the Science Centre to Exhibition Station, to connect more people to more places.

 Crews will be modifying and vacating spaces within the basement of Hudson’s Bay (HBC), which requires crews to work below and above ground. These preliminary construction activities will prepare the site for the future construction of Queen Station.



Timing

- **Work begins October 3rd, 2022** and will continue for several weeks.
- **Work will take place:** Monday to Friday between the hours of 7 a.m.-7 p.m.



What to expect

- To accommodate the future Ontario Line Station, a hydro vault must be relocated, requiring crews to deliver equipment, and set up a construction site along Queen Street.
- The eastbound curb lane on Queen Street, from east of Yonge St. to east of James St., will be closed to vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- There will be a pedestrian detour to the north sidewalk along Queen St.
- A paid duty police officer will be on-site to assist with traffic control.
- There will be signs, construction hoarding and safety barricades to direct pedestrians around the closed sidewalk.
- Generators, trailers, and materials will be left within the hoarded area.
- Businesses near the site can expect to hear noise from the generators.
- Various noise mitigation methods will be used to ensure that the noise limits set by applicable standards and regulations are met.
- Access to the PATH and TTC Line 1 will be maintained at all times.
