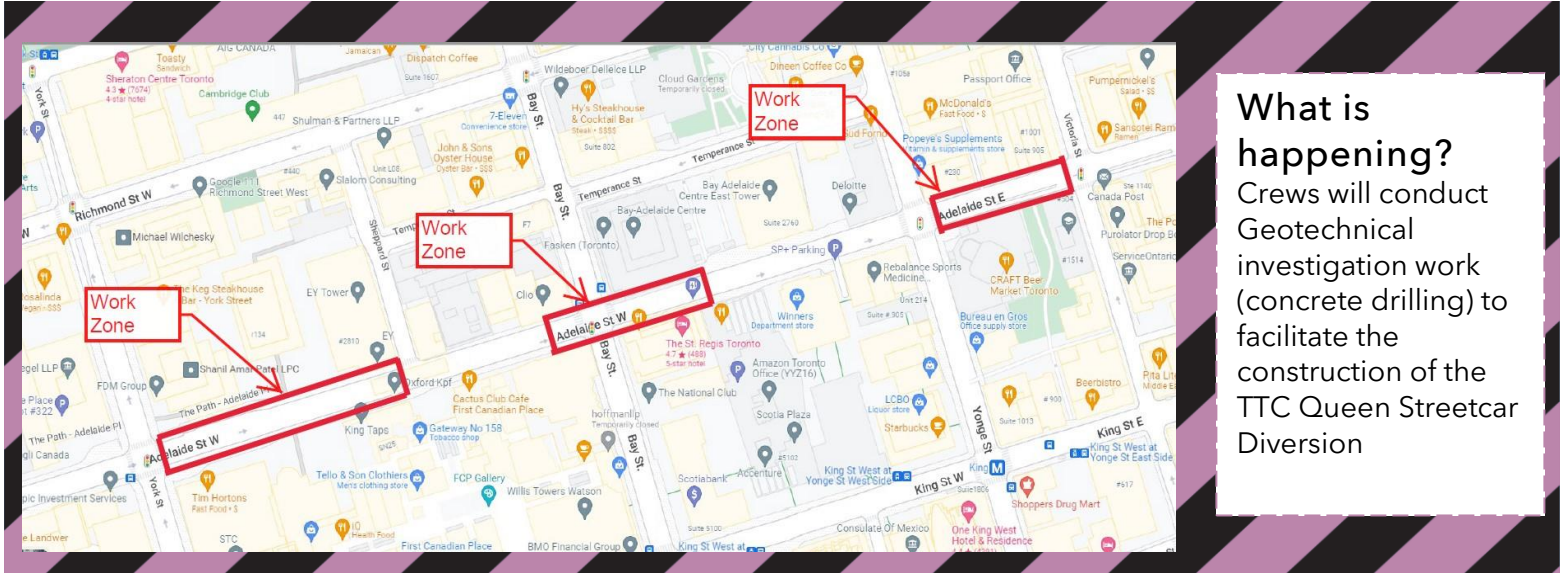


Concrete Coring (drilling) on Adelaide

Starting as early as Oct. 16, 2022



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** Oct 16, 2022
- **Duration:** Two days
- **Days:** Weekdays
- **Hours:** 7 p.m. - 5 a.m.



What to expect

- As part of the Advanced Works Queen Station, crews will conduct concrete drilling using a coring machine on Adelaide St. west from York St. to Victoria St.
- There are six concrete cores to be advanced and each location will be cored in approximately 30 minutes.
- Noise is expected is similar to a vehicle on high-idle, but no vibration is to be expected. The center and south curb lanes are where the work takes place, and the bike path and north curb lane remain open.
- A PDO will be on site as per requirement when working within 30 meters of a signalized intersection.
- Equipment will not be left overnight
