The local project

Metrolinx and its contractors continue work at Rutherford GO Station on a new parking garage, station building, and a road underpass at Rutherford Road.

In support of this work, we are installing new storm sewers along Rutherford Road as part of the storm water management system for the future Rutherford Road underpass.



Construction update

Metrolinx's contractor will be performing work on/along Rutherford Road adjacent to Peter Rupert Avenue. This work will occur overnight from beginning in about late October and continuing into approximately late November. To ensure that the intersection remains open to traffic, the work will be completed in multiple stages. Traffic in some directions will be reduced to one- or two-lane configurations overnight. York Regional Police will be on site to help direct traffic. Lane reductions will occur only overnight and are not expected to affect your daytime commutes.

What this means for you

There will be **overnight construction activity along Rutherford Road near the intersection of Peter Rupert Avenue / Confederation Parkway**, starting at approximately 8:00 pm and continuing to approximately 6:00 am, Mondays to Saturdays, for approximately one month. You might experience noise and dust resulting from construction. If lights are required to complete any overnight work safely, they will be pointed away from households and windows. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience, and we'll make every effort to minimize disruption as much as possible.
