

TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

GO Expansion Program - Rutherford GO Station

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx will transform the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service, you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

Metrolinx contractors continue work on a new 6-storey parking structure with 1,200 net-new spaces and a new integrated station building at Rutherford GO Station. An underpass, i.e. a rail-over-road bridge, is being constructed at Rutherford Road to remove the existing level-crossing and allow for more frequent service.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As part of the on-going works, immediately north of the Rutherford GO Station, the contractor is currently drilling along Rutherford Road to install supporting infrastructure for the excavation of the new Rutherford rail-over-road underpass. **The contractor will soon begin excavation and concrete works for the underpass.**

Drilling east of the tracks along Rutherford Road is expected to be complete by mid-June. Drilling west of the tracks along Rutherford Road is scheduled to commence in late-May, and will continue through to Spring 2021. Excavation for the underpass will begin on the east side starting in mid-May and will continue westward into 2021. Forming and pouring concrete for the new grade separation infrastructure is scheduled to occur during Summer and Fall 2020.



Within the rail corridor, crews will continue construction for the new east platform and supporting pedestrian infrastructure, which is scheduled to open in late Fall 2020. North of Rutherford, within the grade corridor, track works will be required to support of the construction of the rail-over-road underpass.

There will be some overnight work required over the course of the project to complete the works. Every effort will be made to reduce disruptions.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU

As a result of the work, you might experience some noise impacts due to the use of construction equipment. If lights are required to complete the overnight work safely, they will be pointed away from households and windows. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience, and we'll make every effort to minimize disruption as much as possible.
