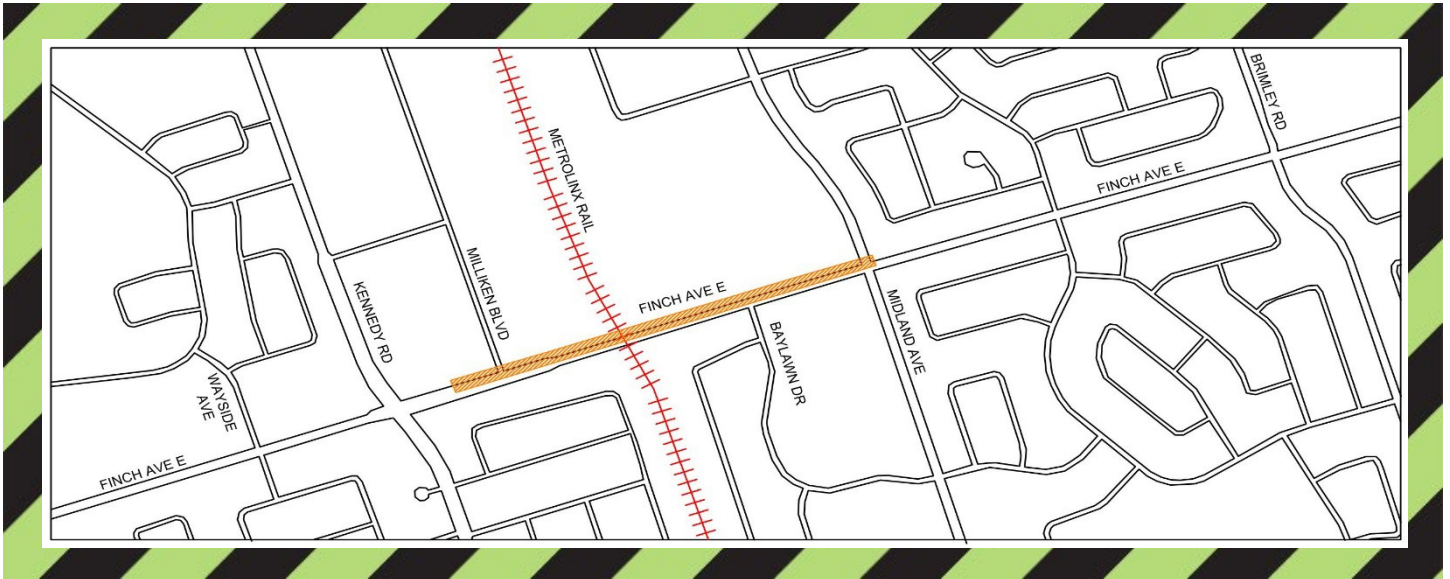


Utility Relocation on Finch Avenue East from Milliken Boulevard to Baylawn Drive

Beginning early May 2022



What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the new SmartTrack Finch-Kennedy GO Station, Enbridge Gas is required to relocate natural gas infrastructure on the north side of Finch Avenue East between Milliken Boulevard and Baylawn Drive.

These pipelines are integral to Enbridge Gas' distribution system and must be re-routed to ensure the safe and reliable delivery of natural gas to customers in Toronto.

What is SmartTrack?

SmartTrack is bringing five (5) new GO stations to Toronto, leveraging roughly 40 km of Metrolinx's pre-existing GO rail corridors within Toronto. The new SmartTrack Finch-Kennedy GO station will be located along the Stouffville Rail Corridor, at Finch Avenue East, between Kennedy Road and Midland Avenue.

SmartTrack is a collaboration between the Province of Ontario, City of Toronto, and Metrolinx that will transform heavy rail infrastructure in Toronto from a regional commuter service into an urban rapid transit network, expanding your local network, creating new possibilities, and bringing you improved access to locations across the city.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start in early May 2022 and will last approximately three (3) months.
- Work will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.
- This project is subject to Ontario Energy Board (OEB) approval. If approved, the new pipeline will be in service by July 2022.
- You will receive another construction notice with more details closer to the start date of the project in May 2022.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Lane reductions may be required on Finch Avenue East between Milliken Boulevard and Baylawn Drive.
- Due to lane reductions delays can also be expected on nearby TTC routes.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city-owned land, should be relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
