


UPDATED: Staircase Construction on Sheppard Avenue East

What is Happening?

As early as February 14, crews will begin constructing the staircase structure on the north side of Sheppard Avenue East, east of the rail corridor. Construction will continue for approximately four months. To perform these works safely, the north sidewalk will be closed to pedestrians for the duration of the work. The south sidewalk on Sheppard Avenue East will remain open. Pedestrians are encouraged to use the signalized crosswalks at the station entrance and at Lamont Avenue to access the south sidewalk.

What to Expect

Crews will be relocating utilities infrastructure, removing existing panels, excavating, pouring concrete, and constructing the canopies at the staircases.

HOURS OF WORK

- Staircase construction will begin as early as February 14 and continue for approximately four months.
- **Work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.**

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- The sidewalk on the north side of Sheppard Avenue East will be closed, between the Agincourt GO Station access road and Agincourt Drive.
- No impacts to traffic on Sheppard Avenue East.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
