



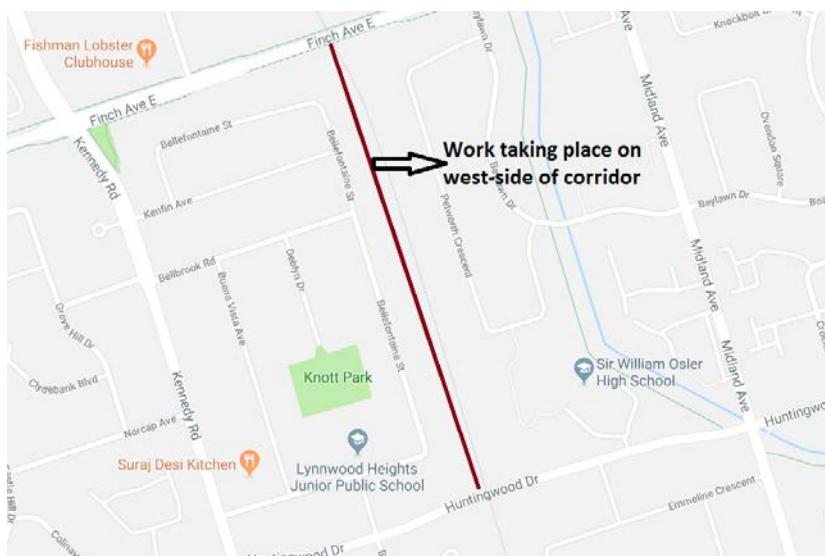
TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

Night-time work on West-side of corridor between Huntingwood and Finch – beginning September 5th

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

As a part our program to expand and improve a 17-kilometre segment of GO Transit's Stouffville line in Scarborough and Markham, construction of noise wall posts is an essential component. To help build these noise walls safely, outside of regular train service times, we are required to complete this work during overnight hours beginning September 4th.



WHAT TO EXPECT

The work will begin at approximately 11:30pm and continue on until 5:00am, with some light drilling involved. While the work covering this entire area between Huntingwood and Finch may take multiple nights, the work should impact any given property on only one night, as our contractor completes approximately eight panels a night. Work will begin in the north, near Finch, and continue southward.
