



TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

Overnight work from October 30 to November 30 Between Marilyn Avenue to Finch Avenue (work to be done in segments)

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.


THE LOCAL PROJECT

As a part our program to expand and improve a 17-kilometre segment of GO Transit's Stouffville line in Scarborough and Markham, construction of the second track along the corridor is a major component. To help install these tracks, they need to be carefully laid over an oil pipeline. This is extensive work that will be required to be done in the late and overnight hours. Thanks to the temporary cancellation of the last train, we can begin this work by 9:30pm.

We apologize for the lateness of you receiving this notice. We pride ourselves in providing at least a two-week notice to residents. However, due to a sudden change with an agreement combined with a very tight schedule, the contractor was compelled to begin work immediately. We sincerely apologize for this intrusion and greatly appreciate your patience with this work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The work will begin at approximately 9:30pm and continue on until 5:00am each night between October 30th to November 30th at the absolute latest. However, please note that each individual area will not be subject to this work for the entire duration, as the work will start from the south (near Marilyn Avenue) and move northwards. The scheduled breakdown is as follows:



Work will begin at Agincourt Drive/Fulbert Drive (between Marilyn and Havendale Rd), starting from October 30th through this week.

Next week (week of November 4th), work will progress northwards from Havendale through the Emmeline Crescent/Tamora/Linwood Crescent neighbourhoods (near Huntingwood Dr).

Starting approximately November 12th (specific dates may be subject to change depending on progression of work) work will move up to Bellefontaine & Petworth Ave neighbourhoods (near Finch Ave).

The nature of the work will be moderate to intermittently loud noise, bright flood lights, back-up machine beepers, and other construction related sounds.
