


GO Train Speed Increases

City of Guelph



The expansion of GO Train service along the Kitchener GO corridor will transform the line into a more frequent transit experience - with fast and convenient train service that runs outside the rush hour.

Metrolinx has been replacing, repairing, and upgrading infrastructure along the Kitchener GO Line in the City of Guelph in support of GO Expansion. To prepare for the future speed increases, Metrolinx recently completed signal equipment upgrades at level crossings that will result in crossing equipment responding to an approaching train much sooner.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

GO Expansion means faster trains and shorter travel times.

Train speeds through Guelph will start incrementally increasing on **October 25, 2021**, with three weeks in between each phase:

- 10 -> 20mph: starting October 25
- 20 -> 30mph: starting November 15
- 30 -> 45mph: starting December 6

On every section of every rail corridor, **train time is any time in any direction**. Safety is central to everything we do at Metrolinx and we urge residents to stay away from the rail corridor and obey signals at all crossings.

While the focus is on educating residents about the dangers and deterrence, Metrolinx Customer Protection officers will also not hesitate to enforce the rules surrounding trespassing on train tracks, which includes a maximum fine of \$5,000.
