


Maintenance Work Between Dublin Street and Wyndham Street

The expansion of GO Train service along the Kitchener GO corridor will transform the line into a more frequent transit experience – with fast and convenient train service that runs outside the rush hour.

Metrolinx has been replacing, repairing, and upgrading infrastructure along the Kitchener GO Line in the City of Guelph in support of GO Expansion. Part of this work includes rehabilitation of the retaining walls between Dublin St. and Wyndham St. as well as the Norfolk St. bridge and the replacement of the Wilson St. bridge.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

- Starting the week of February 22nd, construction crews will set up equipment in **Waterloo Ave Park** to facilitate the next step of this important safety related work.
- This work includes reinforcing and resurfacing the retaining wall.
- Work will generally take place Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Some work will be required on weekends when there is less train activity.
- We will be protecting the larger trees in Waterloo Ave Park. Some smaller trees will be removed and replaced in coordination with the City of Guelph upon completion of work later this year.
- Lane restrictions on Norfolk St. will begin in March to facilitate bridge maintenance. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times.
- The east sidewalk along Wilson St. will be closed to pedestrians for the duration of the work. Notice will be provided for some short term road closures required to replace bridge spans.
- Access to bike lanes will be maintained when possible.
- All businesses in the construction area remain open throughout construction. Residents can expect some construction noise.
