


Level Crossing Improvements

Watson Road, City of Guelph



Metrolinx is undertaking essential maintenance work along the rail corridor from Georgetown to Kitchener on GO Transit's Kitchener Line. Weekend work to upgrade the Metrolinx rail crossing at Watson Road in Guelph will begin on Saturday, July 10.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU

Work at the Watson Road railway crossing will take place **Saturday, July 10** between 7 a.m. - 8 p.m. and **Sunday, July 11, 2021** between 7 a.m. - 8 p.m., with limited works on Monday.

Metrolinx contractor, **PNR RailWorks Inc.**, will install new gate signals, foundations, bells and lights. Watson Road will be closed to all traffic July 10 and 11, only between the hours mentioned above.

During the closure, the Watson Road railway crossing may not be functioning as expected and residents are advised to exercise caution and consider alternate travel routes during the stated road closure times.

Residents may notice noise from machinery. The use of back-up beepers, a vital safety measure, will be limited to essential work only.
