2021 Pipeline Activity - UPDATE

Trans-Northern Pipelines Inc. (TNPI) operates pipelines linking the Montreal, Ottawa, and Toronto regions that carries the fuel we use every day – such as gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, and heating fuel (refined petroleum products). We are committed to operating in a safe and environmentally responsible manner to protect the public, the environment, and the pipeline. This letter is being delivered to you because our pipelines are within 200 metres to your property and we would like to advise you of some upcoming work on these pipelines.

In support of the Metrolinx Lakeshore Go Corridor Project and construction of the Kerr Street underpass and road widening, there will be some activity involving the TNPI pipelines in the area of your property. Due to unforeseen delays, activities are expected to commence on or around April 12, 2021 to remove and relocate the pipeline segments that parallel Metrolinx's railway tracks and pass underneath Kerr Street.

Maintenance work along the existing HydroOne Network utility right of way and near the Metrolinx rail corridor will include limited tree and vegetation removal that impedes typical operation and proposed TNPI construction. Crews will use hand tools, such as chainsaws and pruners, to remove trees and other vegetation that grows into or near existing development. Herbicides may be applied to certain cut stems to prevent re-growth. This activity will start on March 29, 2021.

Construction activities will include use of directional drilling equipment to install the pipelines at a deeper grade to accommodate the new infrastructure required for the Metrolinx Project. Please note there will be a potential increase in traffic and noise during this period and may include additional lighting to be in place. As well, due to the nature of this work, it is unlikely but possible to detect the smell of product during this time. TNPI will have a full-time presence during construction (7 am-7 pm Monday through Saturday) either with TNPI personnel and/or a representative for TNPI. Pipeline activities anticipate being complete by late-August 2021.
