April 22-24 weekend, Union Station East Rail Corridor will be closed to train service to facilitate significant signalling works as Metrolinx prepares for the future Ontario Line alignment. Crews will be at various locations between Cherry Street and Don River, involving all tracks and the Don Yard.

How will you be affected

As there is no train service this weekend works is scheduled day and night. Crews will be performing conduit and cable containment duties in several areas of this construction footprint. Heavy machinery such as vacuum trucks, excavators and dump trucks will be used.

What are we doing about it

Metrolinx is working with subcontractors to ensure white noise backup beepers will be used wherever possible. Track lighting will be directed away from residential communities wherever possible.
