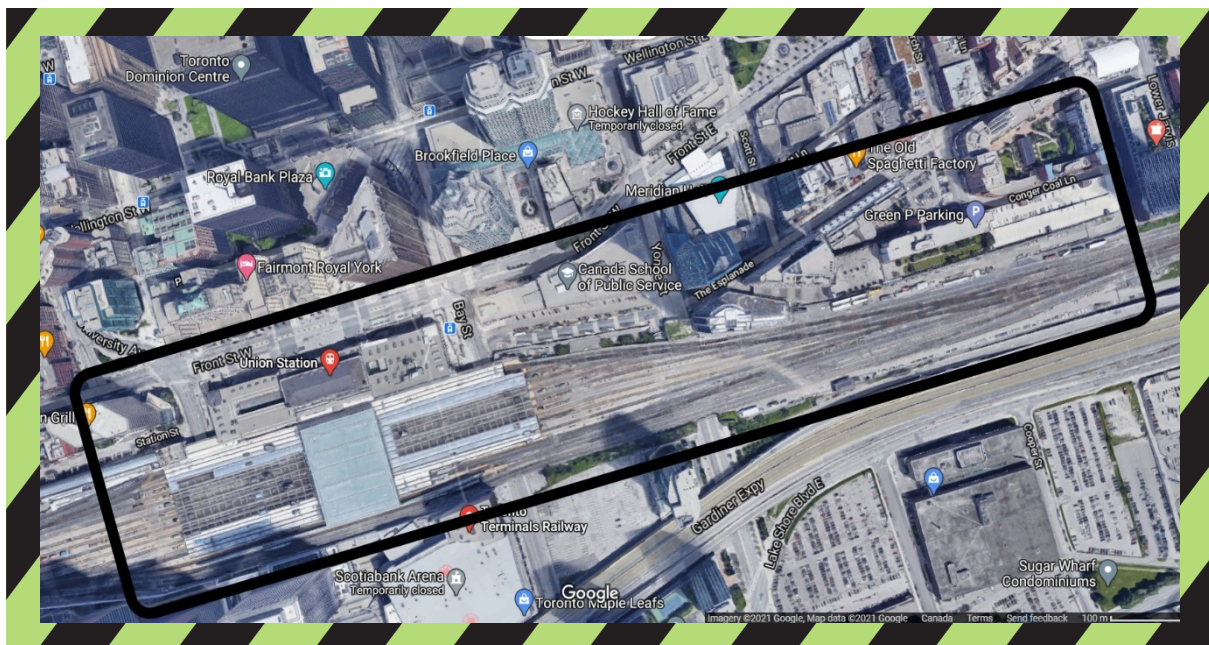


# Signal Project Cable Installation: 55 Hour Work Weekends Continue

Crews will be performing cabling installation and other duties in preparation for new signal bridges between Union Station and Jarvis Street on the following weekends: March 19-22, April 2-5, and April 16-19.

Continuous hours of operation will begin on at 10 p.m. on each Friday evening and continue until 6 a.m. on the Monday morning.

## **How Will You Be Affected?**

Heavy machinery such as vacuum trucks, excavators, jackhammers, boom trucks, and corridor lighting will be used. Metrolinx is working with subcontractors to mitigate impacts by using white noise backup beepers and redirecting lighting away from nearby windows when possible.

## **USRC Signalling System Project Overview**

The USRC Signalling System Project is designed to improve reliability of our signalling and train control systems and will replace the functionality of locally controlled towers at Cherry, Scott, and John Streets.

Early works continue in preparation for new signal bridges at various locations within the Union Station Rail Corridor. Construction and enabling works are estimated to be completed in late 2022.
