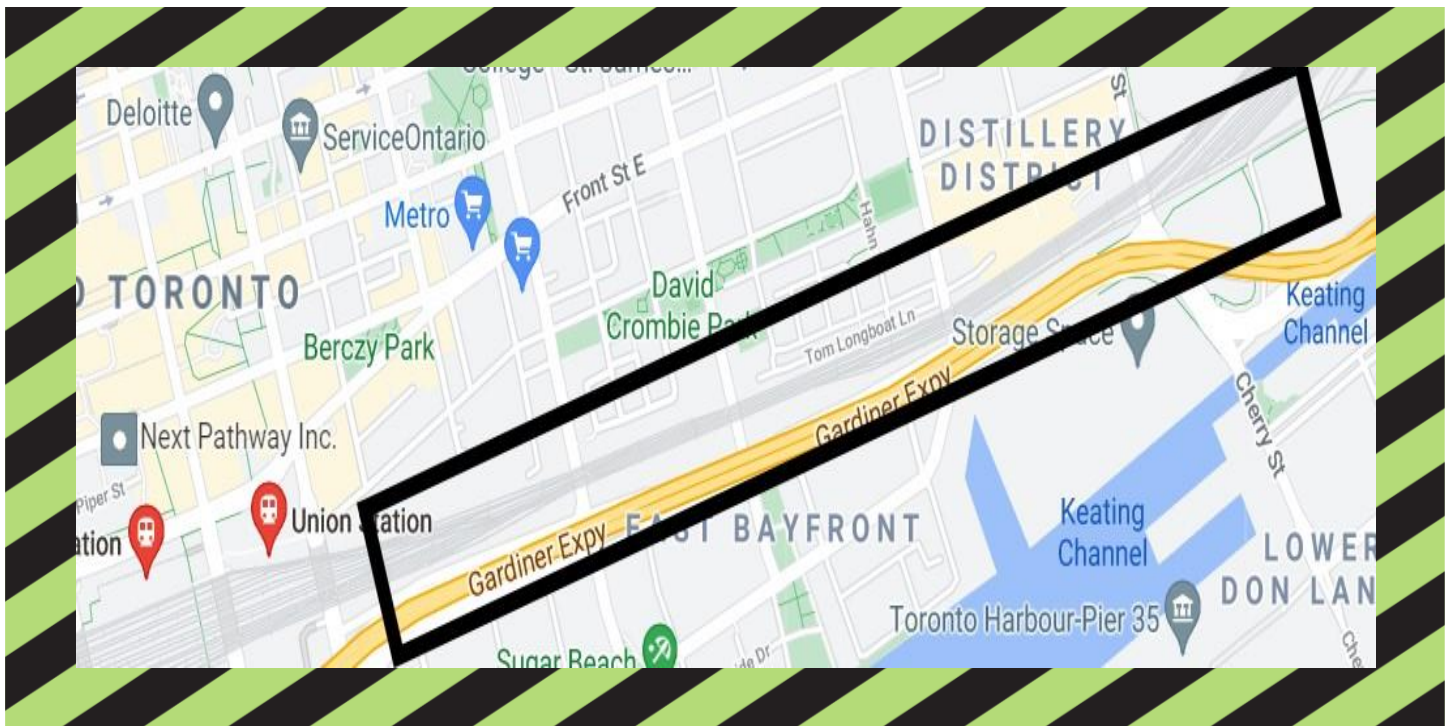


Construction Between Sherbourne and Cherry Streets Beginning May 28

What is happening?

Starting as early as Friday, May 28 rail corridor maintenance crews will be performing significant maintenance work in the East Union Station Rail Corridor between Cherry and Parliament Streets during the day.

Beginning as early as Monday, May 31 to Jun 6, crews will move further west between Sherbourne and Jarvis Streets and switch to overnight work, as the number of tracks involved at this location is far greater.



Why is this work necessary?

Changing and seasonal weather conditions combined with frequent rail traffic will shift track bedding (ballast) over time. To ensure the tracks remain safe and operating efficiently, the ballast is regularly "tamped" or packed back down around the railway tracks. This work is expected to continue into June as it moves through the corridor. Noise and vibration will be experienced by residents closest to the corridor.
