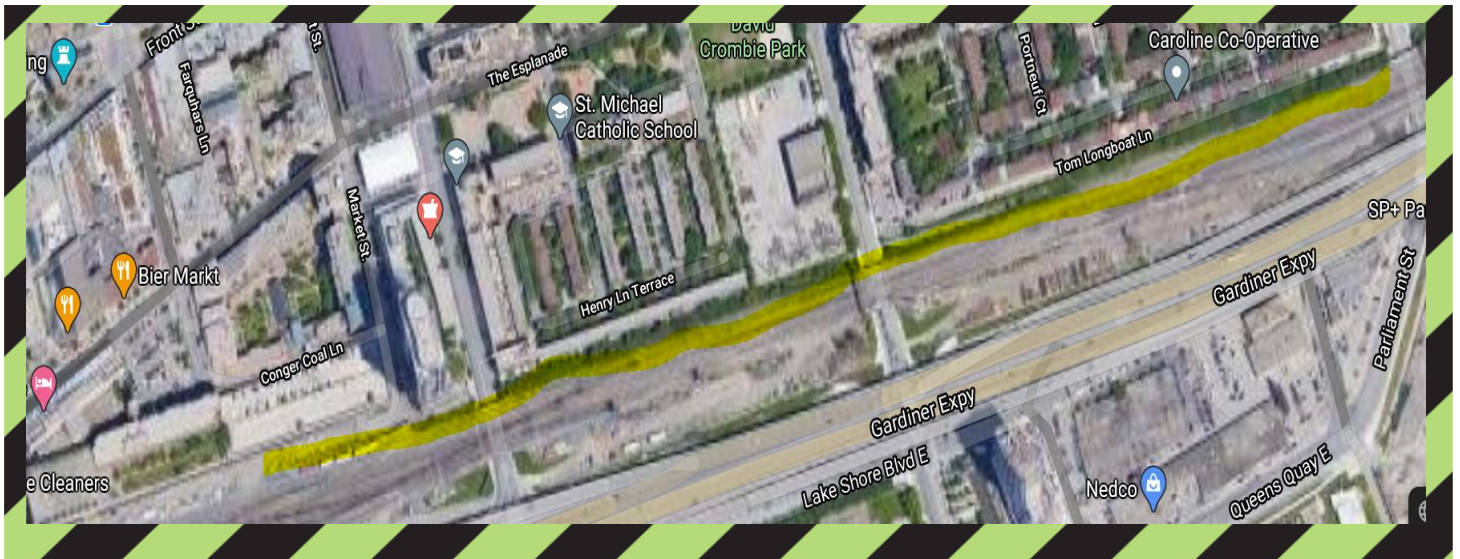


# USRC - Signal/Communications Upgrade Cable Installation and Containment Early Works Scott Street to Cherry Street November 23 - 30, 2020 (night)

## THE LOCAL PROJECT

Metrolinx continues performing early works leading up to new signal communication bridges, scheduled to be installed at various locations within the East Union Station Rail Corridor net year. Next week, new cable installation and containment work will be done overnight between Scott Street and Parliament Street, from 10:00pm to 6:00am. More information on this will be distributed in coming weeks, and through our weekly Toronto East e-Newsletter bulletin.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

The following large machinery and tools will be necessary:

- Hi-rail dry-vacuum truck needed to unearth buried portions of the hydro poles and foundations.
- Articulated boom truck with personnel basket is needed to cut the poles into 3 ft sections for haulage
- Mini Excavator will be used to remove debris
- Concrete Chipper is needed to dismantle the foundation for removal.
