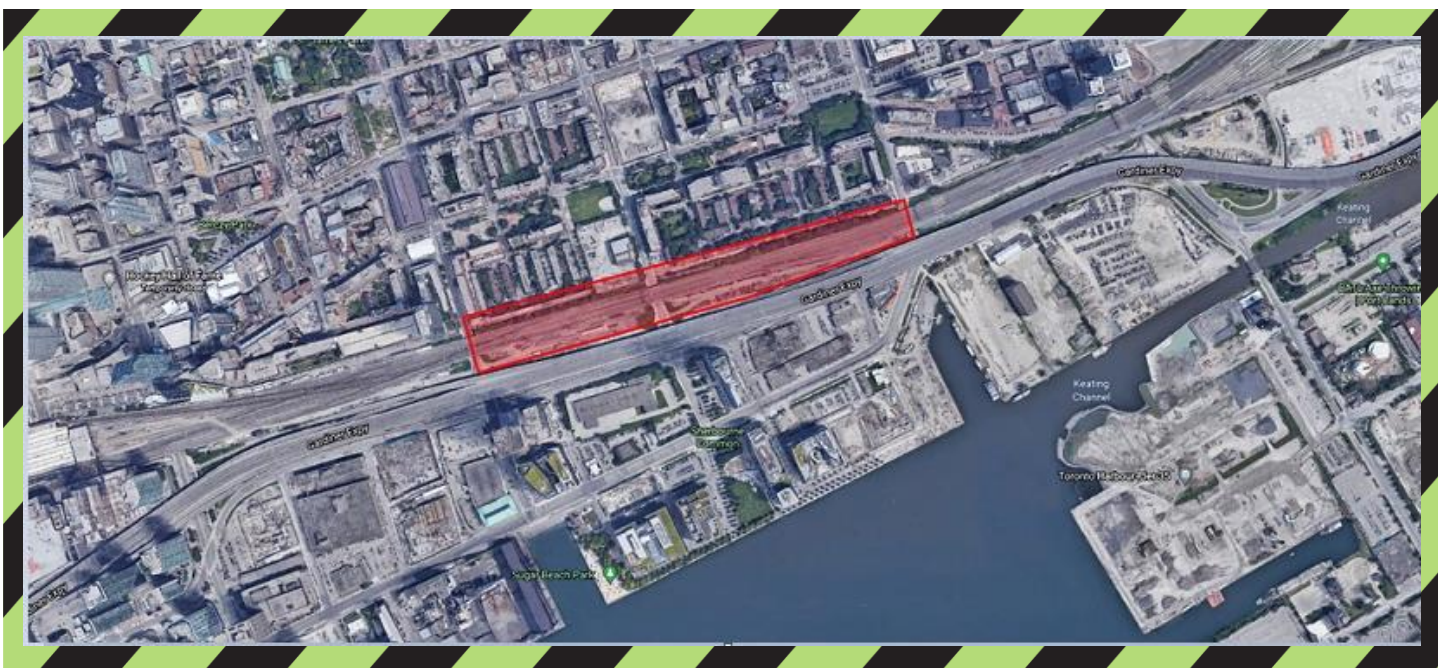


Continuous Signal Bridge and Cabling Work Weekend

Metrolinx will be performing signal bridge installation and cabling work between Lower Jarvis Street and Parliament Street. This work will be done day and night. Continuous hours of operation will begin on at 10 p.m. Friday evening and continue until 6 a.m. Monday morning.

Heavy machinery such as vacuum trucks, excavators, jackhammers, boom trucks, and corridor lighting will be used. Metrolinx is working with subcontractors to mitigate impacts by using white noise backup beepers and redirecting lighting away from nearby windows when possible.

USRC Signalling System Project Overview

The USRC Signalling System Project is designed to improve reliability of our signalling and train control systems and will replace the functionality of locally controlled towers at Cherry, Scott, and John Streets.

Early works continue in preparation for new signal bridges at various locations within the Union Station Rail Corridor. Construction and enabling works are estimated to be completed in late 2022.
