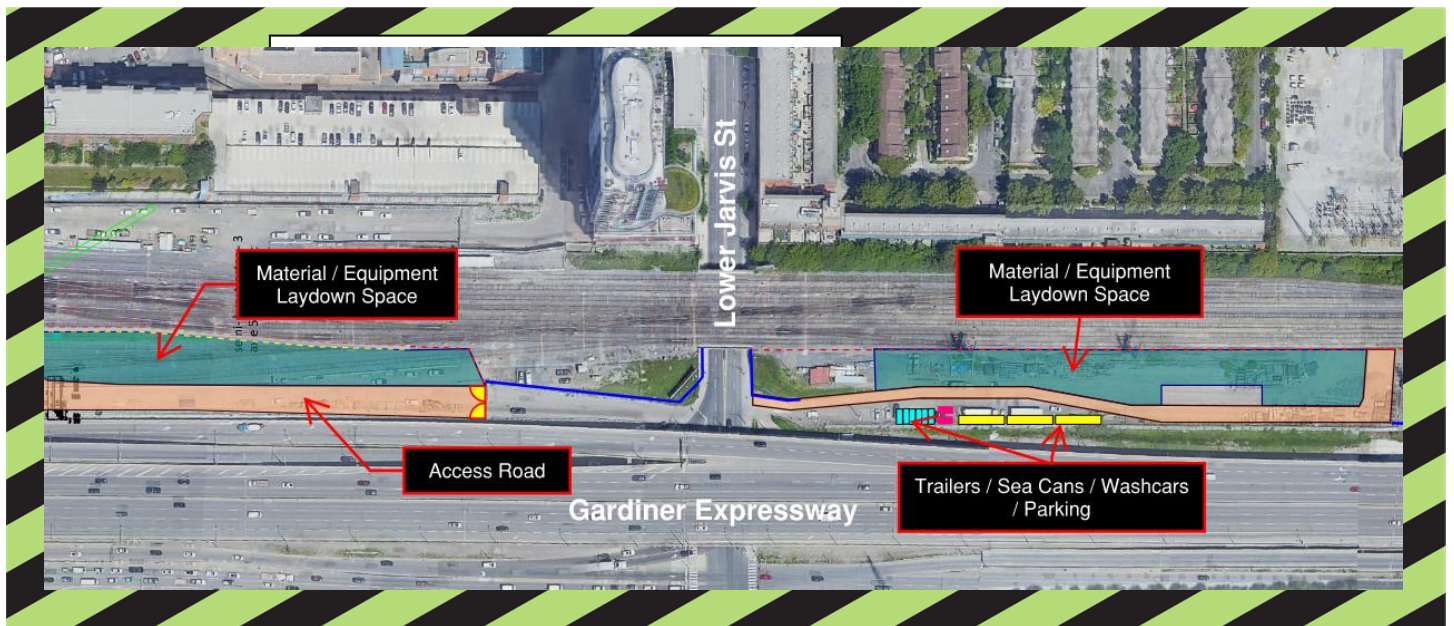


Construction Activities - Jarvis Street to Sherbourne Street, South Corridor

What's Going On?

As early as February work will begin on the Union Station Enhancement Project (USEP) which will affect the station's southern most platforms. A laydown area (where contractors can store materials and equipment safely) has been created east of Union between lower Jarvis and Sherbourne Streets on the south side of the corridor to facilitate this work.

The laydown area will be in place with daily activity between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., with some nights and weekends (as needed) until the end of the multi-year project.

Dates and times may change according to conditions. Safety first.

How Will You Be Affected?

Initially, rail corridor laydown activity will be noticeable but with limited community impact. As the work proceeds, neighbours will see traffic from dump trucks, vacuum trucks, and other heavy machinery. As construction advances, some traffic congestion can be expected along Jarvis Street and Lakeshore Blvd. Further communications will be shared as this impact nears.
