Subsurfacing & Utility Investigation Jarvis to Cherry Sts November 30 - December 4, 2020 (night)

THE LOCAL PROJECT

The Don Yard, in order to meet future service capacity will be expanded with additional track storage to the south, also known as the Wilson Yard. In efforts to facilitate this expansion early sub-surfacing and utility investigation is required. 5 test pits will occur from November 30 – December 4 overnight, from 12:30am to 6:00am, along tracks E3 and E4 from Jarvis to Cherry Streets.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The following large machinery and tools will be necessary:

- Hi-rail dry-vacuum truck needed to unearth buried utility cables.
- Hi-rail backfill truck for replacing ballast.
- Daylighting for clear vision and additional safety.

Community Relations is working with work teams to reduce impacts on neighbouring communities. The nature of this work required after hours access for increased safety. Metrolinx appreciates that some of this necessary work and machinery will be noisier than others and will ensure that its contractors are reminded of neighbouring communities.
